

MEMORANDUM FOR VICE CHIEF OF NAVAL OPERATIONS

SUBJECT: Direction to Appoint a Consolidated Disposition Authority for Possible Accountability Actions Relating to the Investigation of Glenn Defense Marine Asia (GDMA)

(c) R.C.M. 306, Manual for Courts-Martial (2012)

Consistent with references (a) through (c), you are directed to appoint a consolidated disposition authority for matters associated with the investigations of Glenn Defense Marine Asia (GDMA) involving Navy personnel. The consolidated disposition authority shall also dispose of, as he or she deems appropriate, other misconduct relative to Navy subjects of the GDMA investigation that is identified in these investigations or that otherwise becomes known. The Naval Criminal Investigative Service and Naval Inspector General are directed to provide full and complete investigative support to the consolidated disposition authority, as the consolidated disposition authority deems necessary and appropriate.
