



# SEEKING INFORMATION

## \$75,000 REWARD

### LEMONTEE RAMONE STEVENSON

NCIS, the San Diego Police Department, and the FBI are seeking information related to the murder of LeMontee Ramone Stevenson, a US Navy service member stationed in San Diego at the time of his death.

The California Governor's Office, the FBI, NCIS, and San Diego County Crime Stoppers, are offering a combined \$75,000 reward for information leading to a conviction in this case.

On August 17, 2019, at 12:50 a.m., the San Diego Police Department received a report of a shooting at a residence located in the 2700 block of Marcy Avenue, in San Diego. When officers arrived at the scene, they found 19-year-old LeMontee Stevenson suffering from multiple gunshot wounds. Stevenson was transported to a local hospital where he succumbed to his injuries and was pronounced deceased.
