



SEEKING INFORMATION

\$65,000 REWARD **CORNEILIUS DONTÉ BROWN**



NCIS is seeking information related to the murder of Corneilius Donte Brown, a US Navy service member stationed in San Diego at the time of his death.

On April 23rd, 2021, Brown and his roommates hosted a party at their apartment at 4306 Echo Court, in La Mesa, CA. Shortly after midnight on April 24th, 2021, while the party was still active, two unidentified black males wearing black hooded sweatshirts and face masks approached the apartment and knocked on the door. When Brown opened the door, one of the unidentified suspects shot Brown multiple times. Both of the suspects then fled on foot. Investigators believe they had a vehicle waiting nearby.

Paramedics transported Brown to Sharp Memorial Hospital, where he later died as the result of his injuries.

Investigators believe one or more of the suspects were US Navy service members assigned to the USS Abraham Lincoln in San Diego at the time of the shooting, and that the shooting may have been motivated by a personal dispute with Brown or one of his roommates.

Anyone with information related to the shooting, Brown, or his roommates is encouraged to come forward. NCIS, San Diego Crime Stoppers, Brown's family, and the California Governor's Office are offering a combined \$65,000 reward for information leading to an arrest and conviction in this case.
